

Product guide for decontamination of some PPE used by fire brigades

- **Cleaning of breathing apparatus in PPE Dishwashers** – FFE Cleaner + SRP Defoamer + Lejon Kemi cleaning programme
- **Manual cleaning of breathing apparatus** – FFE Cleaner
- **Machine washing of breathing masks** – FPG Wash + FPG Washing bags + (Cleanox Disinfectant) + Lejon Kemi washing programme
- **Manual cleaning of breathing masks** – FPG Wash + Cleanox for disinfection or FFE Cleaner for masks without antifog film
- **Cleaning of fire protective clothing in washing machines** – FPG Wash + Lejon Kemi washing programme for heavily soiled turn out gear
- **Impregnation of fire protective clothing** – SPC Impregnant + programme for impregnation of turn out gear
- **Cleaning of helmets, rubber boots, waterproof tools, machines, work benches etc.** – FFE Cleaner
- **Cleaning of fire hoses** – Lejon Kemi fire hose cleaner (specially developed cleaner for fire hoses)
- **Garage and workshop floors** – Lejon Kemi alkaline Cleaner or FFE Cleaner
- **Fire trucks and cars** – Lejon Kemi Foam Cleaning System + Lejon Kemi vehicle cleaning products

IMPORTANT! Read information on product data sheets, labels and material safety data sheets (MSDS) before use. Chose product based on which item is going to be cleaned and from which type of dirt that has to be removed and cleaning method. Do not use stronger cleaning products than necessary. Do not overdose. Do not use warmer cleaning and rinsing temperatures than recommended. Follow instruction for cleaning from manufacturers of breathing apparatus, turn out gear etc. Also follow instruction how to use and maintain washing machines, PPE dishwashers and high pressure cleaners.

Cleaning effect = Type and concentration of detergent + Cleaning temperature + Cleaning time + Mechanical treatment + Rinsing
